

Many of you will already be aware that our school choir will be taking part in the largest children's choir in the world - **Young Voices!** 

Of our 51 pupils, 22 pupils have been joining me (Mrs Good) for choir rehearsals every week as we prepare to join thousands of other primary school children on **Wednesday 8th January 2025** to perform a huge concert in Sheffield Arena.

We are practising a staggering 12 songs, most of which have dance moves, and one requires us to also learn British Sign Language. Some of the 12 however, are also medleys of up to 6 songs, so we really do have our work cut out for us. This half term the whole school is supporting our efforts to learn and enjoy the music as we sing together on a Friday afternoon. We are hoping to share some of these songs with you at our Christmas events, mixed in with some Christmas classics of course. It's an incredible undertaking and a huge focus for us this term and into the new year. **Thank you** to all of the families involved for supporting their children to learn the songs and attend all our rehearsals. We will give our first public performance at the village hall on **Monday 2nd Dec at the Community Cuppa group at 10.30am.** Pop in if you're free!



On Monday 2nd December – we will be holding a Mini Christmas Market and Christmas Light Switch on! – Join us from 3.15pm in school as the children host their Christmas mini market. Here you will be able to purchase handmade gifts from the children, plus join in with games and get some tasty food and drink treats. There will be the opportunity to purchase tickets for our raffle, that will be drawn at approx. 4pm before we meet around the Christmas Tree for carols and the switching on of our lights. # Shoes in School




Firstly, a massive thank you to all those who have supported school by bringing in an additional pair of shoes for outdoor wear. This has massively helped reduce the clean up in school and ensured our classrooms remain in tip top condition for learning.

We appreciate it has been a change to get used to, but the children are managing this well in school.

Some families have stuck to ensuring that their children are in black shoes during class time by bringing in a pair of plimsolls for indoor use and continuing to use their school shoes for outdoor play.
